Requirements/Responsibilities:

- Assist the Day Camp Director as assigned.
- Focus all your attention on your tasks (don't be distracted by other staff or other things going on).
- Follow an exhausting weekly schedule and remain flexible when needed.
- Maintain a positive and joyful attitude.
- Know when to ask for further instructions from the Day Camp Director.
- Complete the summer staff application process prior to the start of camp.
- Complete online staff training, as well as attend any ongoing staff training at camp.
- Maintain a daily personal relationship with Jesus through personal and staff devotions.
- Attend all daily staff meetings.
- Attend Recap and Rejoice evaluation meeting after camp on the final day of each camp session, if possible.
- Clean all Day Camp areas and help the Dream Team with other cleaning, if possible.
- Rest during your time off (on the weekends etc.).
- Arrive at camp by 1:00 each Sunday afternoon of the week you serve.
- During the Camp Week, do not leave Camp Jonah without informing camp leadership.
- Seek to contribute positively to the quality of the overall camp program.
- Be willing to fill in any position when needed.
- Put aside personal plans and desires for the good of the entire camp.
- Work as a team with the other Day Camp Assistant.
- Work to develop a team spirit and focus with the rest of the summer staff by loving and serving one another.
