Overview:

The Dream Team is the backbone of Camp Jonah, often receiving little recognition for their labors. They are trained in cleaning the building, helping in the kitchen, and facility & yard maintenance, as well as assisting the program with set-up, tear-down, facilitating and or, participating (with campers) in camp activities. The Dream Team may also be called on to lead camp songs, skits and games. A typical work week runs from 1:00PM Sunday through 8:00 PM Friday. A typical work day runs from 7:00AM to 10:00PM with one hour off each day. Dream Team members must have a good work ethic, a joyful attitude and a willing spirit. A Dream Team member must be ready to put aside personal plans and desires for the good of the entire camp.

Job Specifics:

- 1-8 week commitment to live on site
- Meals are provided
- Volunteer position
- Multiple positions available for both males and females
- Availability for two part-time workers per week
- Supervised by the Dream Team Coach

Qualifications/Requirements:

- Age 15+
- Live a life in Christian victory that can be exhibited as well as explained
- Christian Maturity and evidence of continued growth
- A belief that God has called him/her to serve at Camp this summer
- Responsible, respectful, joyful attitude, takes initiative, trustworthy
- Upbeat, fun and positive attitude, no complaining
- Flexible and able to handle change - roll with the punches
- Team player
- Love for youth
- Servant's attitude
- Able to handle high stress, long hours and little sleep
- Dependable with a strong work ethic



Dream Team Positions May Include:

Worship (1)	Lead worship as support for Camp Directors
Media (1)	Take photos and video, upload to archive, create end-of-camp slideshow
Sound (1)	Support audio and visual needs of Camp Directors/Speakers
Kitchen (2)	Help with meal prep, serving and dishwashing
Housekeeping (2)	Maintain a clean facility
Best Friend (2)	Help with campers who may need additional support
J-Crew (2)	“Jeff’s Crew” help with yard and facility maintenance

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Report directly to the Dream Team Coach for your specific work assignments.
- Housekeeping, Kitchen and Program activities.
- Go the extra mile.
- If you see it, make it happen.

- Complete the summer staff application process prior to the start of camp.
- Complete online staff training, as well as attend any ongoing staff training at camp.
- Maintain a daily personal relationship with Jesus through personal and staff devotions.
- Take an hour break each day.
- Attend all daily staff meetings, if possible.
- Attend *Recap and Rejoice* evaluation meeting after camp on the final day of each camp session.
- Assist in cleaning the facilities at the end of each camp session.
- Rest during your time off (on the weekends etc.).
- Attend church on Sunday mornings, when possible.
- During the Camp Week, do not leave Camp Jonah without informing camp leadership.
- Seek to contribute positively to the quality of the overall camp program.
- Be willing to fill in any position when needed.
- Put aside personal plans and desires for the good of the entire camp.
- Work to develop a team spirit and focus with the rest of the summer staff by loving and serving one another.
