DREAM TEAM JOB DESCRIPTION

Overview:

The dream team is the backbone of camp. They get up early, work long days and go to bed late with little recognition for their labors. They will be trained in cleaning the building, kitchen crew, and facility maintenance as well as assisting the program with set-up, tear-down, facilitating and or, participating (with campers) in camp activities. The Dream Team may also be called on to lead camp songs, skits and games. A typical work week runs from 1:00PM Sunday through 8:00 PM Friday. A typical work day runs from 7:00AM to 10:00PM with 1-2 hours off each day. Dream Team members must have a good work ethic, a joyful attitude and a willing spirit. The Dream Team member must be ready to put aside personal plans and desires for the good of the entire camp.

The Dream Team positions are on a weekly basis beginning the week of June 18th and ending after the week of August 27th.

Applying for the Dream Team positions

There are two ways to apply to be on Camp Jonah's Dream Team:

- 1) As an individual
- 2) As a group

Qualifications/Requirements:

- Age 14+
- Live a life in Christian victory that can be exhibited as well as explained
- Christian Maturity and evidence of continued growth
- A belief that God has called him/her to serve at Camp this summer
- Responsible, respectful, joyful attitude, takes initiative, trustworthy
- Upbeat, fun and positive attitude, no complaining
- Flexible and able to handle change - roll with the punches
- Team player
- Love for youth
- Servant's attitude
- Able to handle high stress, long hours and little sleep
- Dependable with a strong work ethic
- Able to work behind the scenes with little recognition

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Before first camp begins, complete the summer staff application process and or necessary forms
- Arrive at camp by 1:00 each Sunday afternoon of the week you serve
- Leave Friday evening after the building is clean, can stay through till Saturday morning if necessary
- Report directly to the Dream Team Coaches and/or adult chaperones accompanying the Dream Team.
- Attend AM staff meetings whenever possible
- Maintain a daily personal relationship with Jesus through personal and staff devotions
- Daily kitchen duties:
 - prep, serve and clean up meals
- Daily housekeeping duties:
 - Clean bathrooms, shower rooms, and other public areas around the facilities
- Daily program duties:
 - Set-up and tear-down activities (recreation, crafts, etc.)
 - being involved in and possibly leading songs, skits, games, crafts, and other activities
